Volunteer Description-Children's Programming

General Statement of Duties: To assist the Program Coordinator in the delivery of Children's Programming at a homeless shelter

Key Areas of Responsibilities:

- Engage in activities with children ages 5-17 yrs old for one hour
-Examples of activities: sports and games outside, arts and crafts indoors, board and card games indoors, watching movies indoors, etc.
- Monitor any programming when Program Coordinator is not present

Skills Needed:

- Ability and desire to work with children ages 5-17 yrs old
- Provide empathetic listening and communication with children and their parents
- Good organizational qualities
- Punctual attendance

Qualifications:

- Be able to pass a background check
- Must maintain confidentiality
- Reliable transportation
- Must be 18 yrs or older

Hours:

1 hour or more per week depending on availability-only during weekdays-afternoons between 1:30-5pm (during the school year) and/or evenings 6-7pm
